Join our club! In our Skate Canada approved CanSkate program, skaters will learn fundamental skating skills for all ice sports:

- Hockey
- Speed skating
- Ringette
- Figure skating

We also offer an amazing STARSkate program for more advanced skaters.

## CanSkate Levels 1–3

CanSkate is a learn-to-skate program for skaters aged 3 years and up. It consists of structured group lessons designed to develop agility, balance and control. Coaches and Program Assistants work closely with skaters to develop their skills. Skaters will be evaluated at the start to determine their level, and will receive a report card upon completion of the session. CanSkate includes our youngest skaters (Pre-CanSkaters).

50 minute classes. Choice of Monday evenings or Saturday mornings.

Half Season (10 weeks) and Full Season (20 weeks) available. Mandatory Skate Canada Fee of \$43.65 applicable for each skater once in the 2022-2023 Season.

### **Mondays 6:05 – 6:55pm**

Oct 3 – Dec 19     \$156.35 + \$43.65 = \$200

Jan 2 – Mar 16     \$156.35 + \$43.65 = \$200

October to March     \$281.35 + \$43.65 = \$325

**Note: no classes Oct. 10<sup>th</sup> (Thanksgiving or Oct. 31<sup>st</sup> – Halloween)**

### **Saturdays 9:05 – 9:55 am**

Oct 15 – Dec 17     \$156.35 + \$43.65 = \$200

Jan 7 – Mar 11     \$156.35 + \$43.65 = \$200

October to March     \$281.35 + \$43.65 = \$325

There is a discount of \$25.00 for each additional sibling, applied once/season.

## Advanced CanSkate Levels 4–6

A structured group lesson for skaters working on CanSkate levels 4, 5 & 6. This lesson includes the development of ice dance, free skate and technical skills.

Skaters at these levels may wish to purchase additional practice time, either on their own or with a coach. Please see the StarSkate section for information on additional ice time and coaching time.

55 minute classes, offered on Mondays.

Skate Canada Fee of \$43.65 applicable for each skater.

### **Fall session (10 weeks)**

Mondays 7:00 – 7:55pm

Oct 17 – Dec 19

### **Winter session (10 weeks)**

Jan 2 – Mar 6

\$461.35 + \$43.65 = \$505

### **What You Need to Participate:**

Skaters up to and including Stage 5 must wear a **CSA HOCKEY** approved hockey helmet. Skates, mittens, long-pants, warm sweater or a jacket are required. Please dress in layers.

## StarSkate

The StarSkate program is designed specifically for figure skating skill development. It allows skaters who have completed the CanSkate levels to develop ice dance, free skate, interpretive and technical skills. Lessons at this level are normally done with a coach, in either semi-private or private sessions (please refer to the other side of the brochure for details). Skaters can also use ice time without a coach.

Ice time is available Mondays and Thursdays. Skaters can choose up to 3 hours/week from the following options:

### **Mondays 7:05-7:55pm**

Oct 17 – Dec 19

Jan 2 – Mar 6

### **Thursdays 6:05–7:55pm (1 or 2h)**

Oct 13 – Dec 15

Jan 12 – Mar 16

There are **no** lessons between Christmas and New Year's.
